

CRESTLINE FARM BARN RULES

General Rules for Riders, Horse Owners and Guests

1. Must sign a liability release form provided by Crestline Farm.
2. Barn hours daily 6am to 9pm. Exceptions are vet emergency or haul-in.
3. No outside dogs allowed.
4. Pick up after yourself. Throw garbage in any of the trash cans on the property.
5. Close doors and turn off lights when you leave the office, tack room, etc.
6. No sandals or flip flops.
7. No smoking, drug use, or alcohol use.
8. No running, screaming or loud music.
9. Children under 12 years old must have adult supervision at all times.
10. No feeding or petting of horses without the owner's permission.
11. Friends, family and spectators must stay outside of the arenas while lessons or riding are in progress.
12. Do not coach your children or friends from the sidelines. For their safety they need to focus on the instructor.
13. Drive slowly and carefully on property. The right of way is as follows: horses; people; vehicles.
14. Abuse of animals or people will not be tolerated in any way. Violators will be asked to leave.
15. If you have questions or concerns please bring them to your instructor or the barn manager.

Rules for Riders and Horse Owners

RIDING:

1. No jumping allowed without trainer supervision.
2. No lunging in the arenas when others are riding without asking permission of riders.
3. When riding, must wear an ASTM/SEI approved helmet (limited number of loaners available). Wear breeches, jodhpurs, jeans or chaps. Wear boots, half chaps, or closed toe, hard-soled shoes. No tennis shoes.
4. Follow ring etiquette rules and show courtesy while riding. Try and follow the same flow of traffic on the flat or ride left shoulder to left shoulder. If unsure call out RAIL or INSIDE/OUTSIDE. When jumping call out HEADS UP, if necessary, to alert other riders.
5. If you are riding during others' lessons, yield the right of way, particularly to those jumping.
6. When in the arena cooling out your horse, please stay off the rail so other riders can have the right of way, and do not ride side by side with other horses when others are riding in the ring.
7. No cell phones during lessons except for emergencies.
8. If any horse gets loose, use reasonable judgment in halting and dismounting until the loose horse is caught.

GROOMING; TURN-OUTS; COURTESY:

1. Clean up after your horse and yourself in the groom stalls and wash racks. Pick up manure and sweep groom stalls. Put away all tack, helmets, supplies, etc.
2. Use cross ties or otherwise tie horses while grooming.
3. Horses are not to be left unattended in any unfenced area.
4. Arenas are to be used for lessons and riding. Arenas may only be used for turn-out when there are no riders or lessons.
5. Turnout time should not exceed 60 minutes.
6. Close gates to arenas, turn-outs and round pen before and after use.
7. Do not borrow any tack, supplies, supplements, etc. from anyone else without their permission.
